How to reach Vellore and CMC

CMC is located in Vellore, the district headquarters of Vellore District, Tamil Nadu. The hospital campus is situated about 2 km from the main bus-stand and 6km from Katpadi junction.

The Medical College Campus at Bagayam is a further 6km from the main hospital.

Those coming to Vellore by train should get off at Katpadi Junction. Town buses (No. 1 & 2) operate regular day and night service from Katpadi railway station via CMC Hospital to the Medical College Campus at Bagayam. Taxis and auto-rickshaws are always available at Katpadi railway station and will charge approximately Rs.250/- for taxis and Rs.125/- for auto-rickshaws to bring you to the main campus and double that to take you to the Medical College. For any help contact the "CMC Help Desk" at the railway station.

Participants who arrive at Chennai and wish to come by bus to Vellore should take an express / "point to point" bus from the bus stand in Koyambedu. This service is available every 15 to 20 minutes and is about 3 hours journey, a distance of 140 km.

For those coming by air, the options available are either to come into Chennai city from the airport (by bus, taxi or metro) and find a suitable connecting train from Chennai Central to Katpadi or a bus from Koyambedu or take a taxi right from the airport to Vellore at an approximate cost of Rs.2400/-

Introduction

At the world congress of the IHPBA at Mumbai (2008) and later at the IHPBA Indian Chapter conference in Bangalore (2009), it was decided to start training programs in hepatobiliary pancreatic surgery under the aegis of the IHPBA.

The first of these programs was the "Certificate Course in HPB Surgery - Indian Chapter of International Hepato Pancreato Biliary Association" (IHPBA), conducted at Hyderabad at the Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, November – December 2009. Since then this course has been conducted twice a year.

Eligibility criteria for admission and intake capacity.

General Surgeons (preferably with 3 years practice) and GI Surgeons / trainees will be eligible for this course. Preference will be given to Indian Chapter members. Applicants must apply in the prescribed form.

All applicants must submit a brief curriculum vitae along with the application form. Candidates who have already participated in previous Certificate Courses are not eligible to apply again.

Complete curriculum of the course and teaching scheme

The five day program will be approximately broken down as follows:

Liver, portal hypertension and transplantation: 2 days

This will include lectures and master videos on liver anatomy, liver radiology, benign liver lesions – haemangiomas, cysts; hepatocellular carcinoma, colorectal metastases, hepatic resections, current management of portal hypertension, overview of liver transplantation etc.

Biliary tract: 1.5 days

Lectures and master videos with interactive discussion with experts on basic principles of biliary surgery, management of benign biliary stricture, difficult cholecystectomy, biliary imaging, cholangitis, choledochal cysts, cholangio carcinoma, carcinoma gall bladder etc.

Pancreas: 1.5 days

Lectures and master videos on benign and malignant pancreatic disease, pancreatic transplantation, trauma etc.

Faculty

Renowned national and international faculty will lead the discussions and present case scenarios, videos, lectures etc.

Overview of the Course:

The course's main objective is to expose the participants to modern HPB thinking and practice. Rather than didactic lectures, the course will mainly be case based. Participants will be taken through the clinical presentation, investigations, management, complications etc., to better understand the disease condition, management and potential pitfalls.

Because this is a full-time, residential program and because of the cumulative and interactive nature of the educational experience, applicants who are accepted must plan and agree to attend and participate in all sessions of the course. There will not be much time for sight seeing / visiting during the course.

It will be advantageous for the participants to update themselves on HPB topics from standard text books.

In addition, we hope to have cadaveric anatomy models, exposure to vascular anastomosis and self learning Radiology modules.
