#### **Course Report**

The certificate course in Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Surgery under the auspices of IHPBA, Indian chapter was held from 7<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> August at JIPMER, Puducherry, India. The course was organized by the Department of Surgical Gastroenterology at JIPMER.

#### Course programme

Daily schedule started at 08.30 am and ended by 07.00 pm although the scheduled time was 05.30 pm. The participants had a very interactive session and had their doubts cleared with the course faculty. The course content included lectures, guidelines discussions, radiology/operative pictorial image discussion, case scenario discussion and Problem oriented discussion and interactive sessions. Course was divided into five days with each day allotted to following titles. Each day, selected faculties co-ordinated the discussions.

- **Day 1- Liver** Imaging diagnosis of liver lesions, malignancies, operative strategies, Benign liver lesions, palliation etc. were discussed.
- **Day 2- Liver transplantation and portal hypertension** Brain death certification, Transplant Law, Deceased organ retrieval, Acute liver failure, Donor evaluation, recipient operation, radiology, portosystemic shunts, Portobiliopathy, Budd-chiari syndrome, Hilarcholangiocarcinoma relevant anatomy, decision making and operative strategies etc. were discussed.
- **Day 3- Gall bladder and bile ducts** Bile duct injury, bile duct strictures, Benign biliary diseases, cancer gall bladder and cholangiocarcinoma, extended cholecystectomy, imaging/interventions etc. were discussed.
- **Day 4- Pancreas** Acute pancreatitis, scoring systems, operations for chronic pancreatitis, resections in carcinoma pancreas, adjuvant therapies, interventions, PNET, Cystic lesions of pancreas, Pancreatoduodenectomy etc. were discussed.


































