- Endoscopy in HPB surgery: Videos/ Lectures
- Practical Clinical scenarios and Clinico-pathological correlation

Eminent national faculties from all over the country will mentor this 5-day course. It is our endeavor to make this course a valuable learning experience for all the participants. This course will not only update young surgeons and residents but will also improve their decision-making capabilities. We invite all young surgeons and residents to attend this 5-day certificate course in HPB surgery.

The course will be limited to 30 participants. The registration fees for the course is Rs 10,000.
